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| Empirical Ayuuk (Denmark, 43%, distillate built around the flavors of Pasilla Mixe, a smoked chili pepper typical of Mexico) | 18 |
| Freya Birch Spirit (England, 40%, is named after the Norse goddess of fertility and is a distillate of birch sap) | 11 |
| Samogon (Latvia, 43%, while vodka is typically produced from the distillation of potatoes or if of higher quality of grain, Rizhskiy Samogon is a very high quality vodka produced from the distillation of pure honey. The distillation of pure honey is evidenced since the Middle Ages by texts pertaining to Kashmiri Slavicism such as the “Tantraloka.”) | 13 |
| Abavas Apple in Oak (Latvia, 42%, inspired by French brandy, it is a distillate of a famous Latvian apple variety, aged in French oak barrels) | 12 |
| Abavas Aroniju Velvet (Latvia, 20%, a fortified wine with a bewitching bouquet of flavors, characterized by the slight sweetness of these typical Latvian berries) | 11 |
| Abolkuka apple pie (Lithuania, 10%, sweet wine created from a combination of Lithuanian apples and exotic spices) | 10 |

Pohjala Beer

The brewery, a pioneer of the brassic renaissance in Estonia, is located in Tallinn, capital of the small Baltic republic. The company was founded in 2011 by four old beer-loving friends; in 2014 the partners equipped themselves with their own facility and hired Scottish brewer Chris Pilkington (formerly of Brewdog) as brewer. Demand grows rapidly due to the unquestionable quality of the beers brewed, which benefit from visuals that do not go unnoticed. The Pohjala Brewery team has worked with dedication, and its reputation is spreading beyond national borders.
